Admission Requirements

Applicants apply for admission to the program via the Graduate School application for admission (https://gradschool.psu.edu/graduateadmissions/how-to-apply/). Requirements listed here are in addition to Graduate Council policies listed under GCAC-300 Admissions Policies (https://gradschool.psu.edu/graduate-education-policies/). International applicants may be required to satisfy an English proficiency requirement; see GCAC-305 Admission Requirements for International Students (https://gradschool.psu.edu/graduate-education-policies/gcac/ gcac-300/gcac-305-admission-requirements-international-students/) for more information.

Exceptions to GCAC-305 (https://gradschool.psu.edu/graduateeducation-policies/gcac/gcac-300/gcac-305-admission-requirementsinternational-students/) will be considered by the program. Exceptions may or may not be granted by the Graduate School.

Other admissions requirements include:

- Application Complete a Graduate School application (http:// gradschool.psu.edu/graduate-admissions/how-to-apply/) including a nonrefundable application fee.
- Statement of Purpose Submit a statement describing how professional experience and goals align with the certificate.
- Vita or resume Submit a statement outlining professional experience history.

GRE/GMAT scores are NOT required.
