The Graduate Certificate in Project Quality Management is a program for students who aim to pursue a career in the fields of Requirements Engineering, Test Engineering and Architecture, and Project Management. Students develop knowledge and skills relevant to Requirements Engineering, Testing Strategy, Testing Infrastructure, Testing Frameworks, Testing Tools, Automated Testing, Continuous Integration, and Project Planning and Management. A certificate will be awarded upon completion of the courses.

Certificate students who wish to have certificate courses applied towards a graduate degree must apply and be admitted to that degree program. Admission to the graduate degree program is a separate step and is not guaranteed.
