BIOSTATISTICS

Admission Requirements

Applicants apply for admission to the program via the Graduate School application for admission (https://gradschool.psu.edu/graduate-admissions/how-to-apply/). Requirements listed here are in addition to Graduate Council policies listed under GCAC-300 Admissions Policies (https://gradschool.psu.edu/graduate-education-policies/).

The language of instruction at Penn State is English. English proficiency test scores (TOEFL/IELTS) may be required for international applicants. See GCAC-305 Admission Requirements for International Students (https://gradschool.psu.edu/graduate-education-policies/gcac/ gcac-300/gcac-305-admission-requirements-international-students/) for more information.

Applicants must complete prior to admission:

- 1. A two-semester graduate-level course in applied statistics from a recognized graduate program. The comparable courses offered by the Department of Statistics are STAT 511 and STAT 512.
- 2. A two-semester graduate-level course in mathematical statistics from a recognized graduate program. The comparable courses offered by the Department of Statistics are STAT 513 and STAT 514.

Prospective applicants must demonstrate:

- For admission to the Graduate School, all applicants must have received from a regionally accredited institution a baccalaureate degree earned under residence and credit conditions substantially equivalent to those required by Penn State. International applicants must hold the equivalent of an American four-year baccalaureate degree.
- 4. Results from one of the following standardized tests taken within the past five (5) years:
 - a. Graduate Record Examination (GRE)
 - b. Graduate Management Admission Test (GMAT)
 - c. Medical College Admission Test (MCAT)
 - d. Law School Admission Test (LSAT)
 - e. (This requirement is waived for applicants who have an advanced degree in a related field beyond the baccalaureate.)
- Completion of the Graduate School application (http:// gradschool.psu.edu/prospective-students/how-to-apply/), which includes three (3) letters of recommendation and a Curriculum Vitae or resume.
