

# EDUCATIONAL PSYCHOLOGY

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## Minor

Requirements listed here are in addition to requirements for minors in Graduate Council policies listed under GCAC-600 Research Degree Policies (<https://gradschool.psu.edu/graduate-education-policies/>) and GCAC-700 Professional Degree Policies (<https://gradschool.psu.edu/graduate-education-policies/>).

At the doctoral level, a minor is also possible in EDPSY. Like all doctoral minors, it requires at least 15 credits of work within the program; the specific requirements for the doctoral minor in Educational Psychology are EDPSY 421 (<https://bulletins.psu.edu/search/?P=EDPSY%20421>), EDPSY 450 (<https://bulletins.psu.edu/search/?P=EDPSY%20450>), and EDPSY 505 (<https://bulletins.psu.edu/search/?P=EDPSY%20505>), plus at least two other courses in EDPSY, in consultation with the minor adviser. The minor adviser should be a member of the Graduate Faculty and should be appointed to the student's Ph.D. committee as early as possible.
